On September 30, 1943, USS The Sullivans was commissioned in memory of the five, brave Sullivan brothers who all died on the same day, November 13, 1942, during World War II.

The Irish American brothers became the first, multiple-person namesake of a ship in US Naval history. Many families have sacrificed their loved ones in the fight for freedom over the centuries, but few have lost so much in so short a space of time as the Sullivan family.
